VESTRA RESOURCES INC. MATH, SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP

SUMMARY

VESTRA Resources, Inc. is a multidisciplinary consulting firm providing engineering, surveying, environmental, and geospatial information technology services. Fields of engineering, surveying, environmental science, and GIS require well-trained, well-educated staff. VESTRA will award up to \$5,000 in scholarships in 2024 designed to encourage careers in the fields of math, natural or physical science, technologies, and related areas of study. Additional funds may be allocated based on committee recommendations. The scholarships are open to Shasta County residents and/or high school graduates attending a Shasta County high school who will be attending an accredited 4-year college or university, students transferring from a 2-year or junior college program to a 4-year accredited college or university, and continuing students at 4-year accredited colleges or universities in the fields of math, natural or physical sciences, technologies, and related areas of study. Scholarships are based on academic performance, leadership potential, and career interest. Scholarships are not based on financial need.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the scholarship is to recognize and assist outstanding, young high school graduates and college/university undergraduates pursuing careers in the math, science, technologies, and related fields. The scholarship program's goal is to aid in the cost of attendance at a 4-year college, including tuition and fees, room and board, and related expenses.

ELIGIBILITY

The program is limited to residents of Shasta County and/or high school graduates currently attending a Shasta County high school. Students attending colleges/universities outside Shasta County or out of state may apply as long as they have not changed their residency status. Applicants must be planning to attend or attending a 4-year accredited college or university. The scholarship does not apply to 2-year or junior college programs. Applicants must possess a minimum GPA of 3.5 unweighted as a graduating senior and continuing college/university student. The scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors, students transferring to a 4-year college or university, and those students enrolled in a full-time undergraduate course of study at a 4-year college or university. Previous scholarship recipients may reapply in order to compete for one additional year. The nature of the scholarship is merit based. Preference will be given to applicants who have completed calculus or statistics, or other advanced classes in math, science, and technology.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Applicants should complete the application package (attached). The package, including the required attachments, must be postmarked by **Friday, March 29, 2024.**

The application package should include:

- 1. Completed application
- 2. Certification from registrar, dean of students, guidance Counselor, or other appropriate individual that the applicant is currently enrolled as a **full-time** student in **good standing**.



- 3. Current transcript
- 4. Three (3) letters of recommendation addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letters of recommendation should be from any combination of the following:
 - Teacher in math, science, or technology field
 - Professional in proposed field of study or other area
 - Other person(s) knowledgeable of the applicant
- 5. A copy of your college entrance essay or related work for high school seniors and transfer applicants; writing sample for college/university applicants
- 6. For high school seniors and transfer students, proof of acceptance to a 4-year college or university if available. If not available, will be required prior to award.
- ** Previous VESTRA Scholarship Recipients applying for one additional year, please include updated college/university-related information.
